- 9 Dr. Spayd stated ASPPB will not enter into a 10 contract with any state that does not subscribe to 11 both parts.
- Dr. Small added the Board of Directors of ASPPB
 made this decision on their own and did not consult
 the membership. Dr. Small explained ASPPB propagated
 a change in its bylaws that allows the Board of
 Trustees to make decisions on behalf of the
 jurisdictions without their vote.
 - Dr. Small reviewed the item development in 2018, beta testing in 2019, and the projected roll out in January 2020.
