21 everyone that the Bureau of Professional and

22 Occupational Affairs (BPOA) received reports that

23 persons pretending to be from one of the health-

24 related boards are contacting licensees by phone and

25 mail about the status of their licenses.



1 Ms. Miley noted scammers are altering information  
2 on caller ID to appear to be from the Commonwealth of  
3 Pennsylvania and threatening license suspension for  
4 failure to act and falsely claiming involvement with  
5 federal agencies, such as the Federal Bureau of  
6 Investigation (FBI) and the Drug Enforcement  
7 Administration (DEA).

8 Ms. Miley stated scammers are known to threaten  
9 license suspension for failure to provide personal  
10 information. She provided reminders from BPOA  
11 concerning contact and personal information for  
12 licensees and applicants.

13 Ms. Miley noted licensees would never be  
14 contacted by phone for payment. She reminded everyone  
15 to never provide personal or financial information  
16 over the phone, text message, or fax. She mentioned  
17 that those who are the subject of an investigation or  
18 disciplinary action will receive notice by certified  
19 mail and/or personal service and are provided with a  
20 contact name and phone number. She informed everyone  
21 to contact their local police department or the  
22 Pennsylvania State Police if they have been a victim  
23 of the scam.]


