Ms. 23 Cardone stated the mobility issue was voted on and 24 approved by the states. The states will attempt to 25 work together and identify rules, regulations, and

policies within their regulations that would stand in 1 2 the way of mobility across states. She noted that ASWB 3 will work on this issue and provide direction. Ms. Cardone stated licensees will be responsible 4 for contacting ASWB and placing their own information 5 6 into the databank. 7 Ms. Cardone discussed the four qualification criteria, including passing the clinical or 8 appropriate exam in one state. She stated those who 9 10 were grandfathered in for licenses might not qualify, 11 which would be a decision made by each individual 12 state. Ms. Cardone commented that it was not 13 guaranteed that with proceeding with the mobility 14 initiative that all licensees would be licensed in 15 other states. Ms. Cardone offered to attend the next ASWB 16 17 meeting in Nova Scotia in May 2018. Ms. Matter will 18 see if Board members are permitted to travel outside 19 the United States.] 20 \* \* \* 21 Report of Committees 2.2 [The Board discussed possible supervision subcommittee 23 meeting dates, as well as individual research in 24 preparation for the meeting on March 27, 2018, at 8:15 25 a.m.

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Ms. Cardone questioned whether research regarding 1 2 mobility should be done publically and whether the 3 rules and regulations should be reviewed. Dr. Corby suggested waiting until the results of 4 5 the Commissioner's study were available as regulations 6 may need to be reviewed at that time. Dr. Corby noted 7 the language by the Association of Marriage & Family Therapy Regulatory Boards (AMFTRB) could possibly 8 9 cover any license. 10 Chair Matta suggested the committee wait until June to incorporate the mobility issue and reassess it 11 12 at that time.
