Veterinarians who are accredited under the new National Veterinary Accreditation Program are required to complete APHIS Approved Supplemental Training (AAST) credits for every three year renewal period. If you chose to be a Category I accredited veterinarian (cats, dogs, pocket pets) then you are required to complete three (3) of the modules in each renewal cycle. If you chose to be a Category II accredited veterinarian (all species) then you are required to complete six (6) of the modules in each renewal cycle.

The PA State Board of Veterinary Medicine will accept these courses toward your biennial renewal requirement of 30 contact hours. Please be aware, however, that per §31.15 of the Board's regulations, a maximum of 25% (7.5 hours) of the required 30 contact hours may be earned by taking online or home study courses.
